Good Hope City Council Minutes
July 10, 2017

1. Mayor Guthrie called the meeting to order. Mayor Jimmy Guthrie led the invocation.
Councilman William Malcom led the pledge.

2. Roll Call was performed by City Clerk Renette Yancey. Councilman Joshua Jameson and Councilman David Mullis were absent.

Due to the lack of attendance a quorum was not established, therefore no business could be conducted. Mayor Guthrie gave the Committee Reports and Updates. All other business on the agenda will be discussed at next months' meeting.

3. Committee Reports/Updates:

A. Playground Fence – Mayor Guthrie met with Brian Sullivan and Rob Rojas from Sullivan and Wickly along with some of the cities citizens to discuss their concerns regarding the need for a fence to surround the Good Hope playground. Mr. Sullivan agreed to pay for the purchase and installation of the fence. A quote will be submitted to Sullivan and Wickly from Paul Roberts of Roberts Fence Company. It will be a 4-foot fence with a heavy gage black coated wire.

B. Budget Report – The Mayor acknowledged that we are on track with most of the budget. The only areas of concern seem to be the lack of funds received for business license. This should be rectified by the end of the year. Our Dues/Fees budget is ahead of spending partly due to an overlap of last years' bookkeeping and the cost increase of the monthly Municipal Meeting.

C. Municipal Street Maintenance 2017 – The Election office sent the Street Maintenance Report to the City for us to verify the streets and the house numbers within the Good Hope city limits. Mayor Guthrie did some checking and made the necessary changes due to the homes that have been built within the city limits in the last few years. This report helps the county with voter registration and will be used in the upcoming census.

D. 2018 LMIG Grant – The 2018 LMIG Grant Application has been received by the city in the amount of \$6784.05.

E. Comprehensive Plan Update – The city received a letter from Community Affairs declaring that Good Hope is in good standing regarding their Local Government Status.

10. Mayor Guthrie called for a motion to adjourn the meeting. Councilman Keith Prather made that motion and Councilman William Malcom seconded. Motion passed and the meeting was adjourned.
