Good Hope City Council Minutes June 3, 2019

- 1. Call to Order:** Mayor Guthrie called the meeting to order. Councilman William Malcom led the invocation. Councilman Josh Jameson led the pledge.
 - 2. Roll Call** was performed by Mayor Guthrie, Renette Yancey and Jason Laughinghouse were absent.
 - 3. Approval of Agenda:** Councilman Keith Prather made a motion to accept the agenda. Councilman William Malcom seconded, all approved and the motion was passed.
 - 4. Approval of previous meeting's minutes:** Councilman David Mullis made a motion to accept the May Council minutes. Councilman Josh Jameson seconded. All approved, Motion passed, and minutes were recorded.
 - 5. Public Forum:** There was no Public Forum.
 - 6. Committee Reports/Updates:**
 - A. Emergency Generator:** Mayor Guthrie updated the council on cost of propane tanks for the emergency generator. Loyal Gas of Conyers said that the yearly rental was \$58.75 and Piedmont Gas which is used by Good Hope General said that it's yearly rental would be \$45.00 and would give us the same price for gas as they do Good Hope General. Councilman Malcom is checking into Natural Gas and will report at the July meeting.
 - B. Sheriff's Precinct in Good Hope.** Mayor Guthrie reported that everything was moving forward, and the County Attorney and City Attorney Mike Malcom were working on a Memorandum of Agreement with the County for the use of our Archives Building as the Precinct. Mayor Guthrie said that he would keep the Council informed.
 - C. Sidewalk Update.** Mayor Guthrie stated that all of the permits and paperwork had been issued and Sims Paving would start as soon as they could.
 - D. Agreed Upon Procedures.** Mayor Guthrie stated that audit was complete and the necessary paperwork had been submitted to the State. The council Members and City Clerk were given copies of the audit for their personal files and City Files.
