**Good Hope City Council Minutes
April 6, 2020**

Due to the Covid-19 virus this meeting was held via conference call / City Hall

1. **Call to Order:** Mayor Guthrie called the meeting to order. Councilman Keith Prather led the invocation. Councilman Jason Laughinghouse led the pledge.
2. **Roll Call** was performed by City Clerk, Renette Yancey. Mayor Guthrie, Councilmen Keith Prather, Jason Laughinghouse and William Malcom attended City Hall. Councilmen David Mullis and Josh Jameson as well as City Clerk Renette Yancey were on the conference call
3. **Approval of Agenda:** Councilman Keith Prather made a motion to accept the agenda. Councilman William Malcom seconded. All approved and the motion was passed.
4. **Approval of previous meeting's minutes:** Councilman Keith Prather made a motion to accept the March Council minutes. Councilman Jason Laughinghouse seconded. All approved, Motion passed, and the minutes were recorded.

Councilman Josh Jameson seconded, all approved, and the motion passed.
