Good Hope City Council Meeting
Date December 7, 2020

A town meeting was scheduled to discuss the 2021 Budget for the City of Good Hope. No Good Hope residents were in attendance, so no business was discussed concerning the 2021 Budget.

1. Call to Order/Invocation/Pledge of Allegiance: Due to Mayor Guthrie's absence, Vice Mayor/Councilmember David Mullis chaired the Council Meeting. Councilmember Kelsey Malcom gave the invocation and Councilmember William Malcom led the Pledge of Allegiance.

2. Roll call: City Clerk Renette Yancey took roll call. Mayor Jimmy Guthrie was absent, all others were present.

3. Approval of agenda: Councilmember Keith Prather made a motion to accept the agenda. Councilmember William Malcom seconded, all approved and motion was passed.
