Good Hope City Council Minutes March 1, 2021

- 1. Call to Order:** Mayor Pro-Tem David Mullis called the meeting to order. Councilman Keith Prather led the invocation. Councilman Kelsey Malcom led the pledge.
- 2. Roll Call** was performed by City Clerk Renette Yancey. All were present
- 3. Approval of Agenda:** Councilman Keith Prather made a motion to accept the agenda. Councilman William Malcom seconded. All approved and the motion was passed.
- 4. Approval of previous meeting's minutes:** Councilman William Malcom made a motion to accept the February Council minutes. Councilman Keith Prather seconded. All approved, Motion passed, and minutes were recorded.
- 5. Public Forum:** As part of the requirements of Leadership Walton, Brandy Atha and Cassie Atha were in attendance.
- 6. Committee Reports/Updates:**
 - A. Budget Update.** Mayor Pro-Tem gave the Year-to-Date budget report. Everything is on track for the year.
 - B. GDOT Application Update** This application process began last November. 24 hours before the due date they called and said it was incorrect. Our application was signed by Todd Parker but they wanted it signed by a member of the city. Our application has been approved now and we are waiting on permits so we can move forward.
 - C. LMIG Update;** We are in compliance with the state to receive money from the state. Monies received will be spent on the sidewalk project down Pleasant Valley Road.
- 7. Unfinished Business: Roof Leak** - Mayor Pro-Tem David Mullis will be meeting with Bone Dry Roofing about the leak in the roof at City Hall on Wednesday March 3rd at 8:30am. Council Member Keith Prather made the motion to spend up to \$1500 for repair of the roof. Council member Kelsey Malcom seconded. All approved and the motion passed.
- 8. New Business**
 - A. Special Election Update** - Qualifying for the position of Mayor and City Council Post 4 will be March 3rd, 4th and 5th from 9 until 12 at City Hall. The Special Election is scheduled for March 16th.
 - B. Ga Ethics Filings** - The council turned in their forms for Ethics filing. City Clerk Renette Yancey will file them with the state.

Council Discussion

- A. City Hall Rental in** - After being closed due to Covid 19, City Hall will reopen for rental beginning April 1st.
- B. COVID-19** - Cases are going down. With the Johnson and Johnson vaccine as well as the two already in place, Moderna and Pfizer, this should help increase the amount of people being vaccinated.
- C. Other Donald Poss** is in the process of selling property for housing on Queens Cemetery road.
- D Piedmont Timber** has applied for and received a Letter of Compliance to do logging on Bearden Road.
- E City Clerk Position** - Due to City Clerk Renette Yancey, having a full-time job elsewhere she doesn't feel she has time to devote to the City in a way that is worthy of the citizens of Good Hope. Therefore, she will be resigning from the position as City Clerk. The council was asked to contact anyone that they think would be qualified for the job.
