Good Hope City Council Minutes September 12, 2022

- 1. Call to order: Vice Mayor and Councilmember David Mullis called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm, Councilmember Keith Prather led the invocation and Councilmember Kelsey Malcom led the pledge.
- 2. Roll Call: City Clerk, Missy Daigle took the roll, all of the Councilmembers were present, Mayor Randy Garrett was absent due to illness.
- 3. Approval of agenda: Councilmember Keith Prather made a motion to approve the agenda and Councilmember William Malcom seconded the motion and all approved.
- 4. Approval of previous meeting's minutes: Councilmember William Malcom made a motion to accept August Council minutes, Councilmember Kelsey Malcom seconded, all approved, motion passed and minutes were recorded.
- 5. Public Forum: Doyle Wallace, Pastor of the Good Hope Christian Church, his wife Tonya, and Jim Howell were present.
- 6. Committee Reports/Updates:
- A. Budget Update: The council was presented with a year-to-date report. Councilmember Kelsey Malcolm made a motion to accept the budget report and Councilmember Keith Prather seconded the motion. All were in favor and the budget report was approved.
- B. City Hall Rentals: It was discussed that we should find out from the Fire Marshal the number of occupants that the building can hold and place signage that reflects that as well as adding it to the rental agreement.
- C. Agreed Upon Procedures (2021): City Clerk, Missy Daigle spoke to the CPA on September 12th after the CPA reached out to get information required to finish the Agreed Upon Procedures. At that time no date was given when things would be completed.
- **D.** TSPLOST talking points: A handout was given to all of the Councilmembers to help them to be able to answer any questions that they may be asked concerning TSPLOST in the upcoming election, a copy of the information is on file in the Clerk's office.
- 7. Unfinished business: There was no unfinished business.
- 8. New Business:
- A. Reading(s) of Flood Damage Prevention text amendment to Land Development Ordinance: Councilmember David Mullis did the second reading of the amended ordinance. The first reading took place at a Special Called Meeting of the P&Z Committee, where after being advertised in the local paper, no one from the community was present and there were no disputes. The third reading will take place at the October City Council Meeting, the new ordinance, "2022" will replace the 10.4 Flood Damage Prevention Plan. After the reading there was discussion from the public, Jim Howell, who is having drainage issues. Jim and his neighbor reside off of Pleasant Valley and are very concerned about the flooding on their properties. Councilmember Keith Prather was going to look further into the situation.
- B. Santa's Workshop: Councilmember Kelsey Malcom brought a request to the council about having a Santa Workshop at the Good Hope City Hall. The not for profit, Good Hope Together,

will be hosting the community event. There will be cookie decorating, pictures with Santa, making ornaments, Christmas trees, and many other activities. After some discussion, Councilmember John Robison made a motion to have the Santa Workshop, Councilmember Keith Prather seconded the motion and it passed 100%.

- 10. Adjourn: Councilmember Keith Prather made a motion to adjourn the meeting, Councilmember William Malcom seconded, all approved and the meeting was adjourned at 7:15 pm.
